## Six Super Strategies

<p><b>Question</b></p> <p>Ask questions that you wonder about as you read, listen, or observe.</p> <p>“Who” “Did What” “Where”  “When” “Why” I wonder if.....  “What is happening?”</p>	
<p><b>Visualize</b></p> <p>Picture in your mind what you are learning. What actions and objects do you see? (Or draw a picture, act it out)</p> <p>“I see.....” “I picture”</p>	
<p><b>Connect</b></p> <p>As you learn, ask yourself what this reminds you of? Think about your past experiences or knowledge.</p> <p>“This reminds me of.....”</p>	
<p><b>Infer</b></p> <p>What do you think you know even though you were not told? What reasons do you have for your idea?</p> <p>“I think.....because.....”  “I infer that.....because.....”</p>	
<p><b>Predict</b></p> <p>Periodically stop and think about what might happen next. Tell what clues make you predict that.</p> <p>“I predict that.....because.....”  “My hypothesis is...”</p>	
<p><b>Conclude</b></p> <p>What is the big idea? What is it all about? What conclusion can you make?</p> <p>“I conclude that.....”</p>
